One of his designs has been internationally recognized and exhibited at locations such as the New York Hall of Science and the New York Public Library. Keith currently teaches and researches in the area of computer games at the University of Newcastle.










# **Jailbreak 8 (2007)**

Oil on 8 canvases (original) 1250mm x 474mm




#### Here and Now (2010)
